Dear Ms. Schellin,

At a regularly scheduled and properly noticed¹ meeting on October 17, 2012, our Commission voted 6-0-0 (with five Commissioners required for a quorum) to support the Gallaudet campus plan through 2022 and further processing so that the details of specific projects can be reviewed at a later time.

Hansel Bauman, the Director of Campus Design and Planning, presented the project on behalf of the applicant. Mr. Bauman described three upcoming phases of development and the principles of the master plan, which include:

- 1) An opportunity to engage the city in a new way, with the main point of entry on Florida Avenue and a new pedestrian point of entry at the intersection of Florida and Sixth Street.
- 2) An opportunity to strengthen the academic heart of the campus

Gallaudet has undergone a series of community outreach sessions throughout this year to gather input from the public, as well as faculty and staff. The University has received support from ANC5B on October 4th, and is requesting support from ANC6C.

ANC 6A appreciates Gallaudet's outreach efforts to our ANC and looks forward to working with them in the future to address common issues of concern.
