Dear Ms. Kress:

At Advisory Neighborhood Commission 6C's duly noticed, regularly scheduled monthly meeting on October 11, 2006, with a quorum of 7 out of 9 commissioners present and voting, the matter of Fun Fair Video came before us; specifically, its appeal for a revocation of certificates of occupancy and the issuance of a cease and desist order for operating a sexually oriented business. The property is located at 919 Fifth Street N.W.

Previously ANC 6C commissioners voted on July 12, 2006, regarding the nature of the business activities of Fun Fair Video and the negative effect on the neighborhood. At that time, the vote was unanimous in favor of opposing the appeal of JMM Corporation. The July 17, 2006, letter indicating that decision of ANC 6C is attached.

ANC 6C continues to oppose this establishment for the same reasons stated above, that is, its negative impact on the families of the residential community, and unanimously agreed again on October 11, 2006, to oppose the appeal of JMM Corporation. The commissioners urge the BZA to allow the decisions of the Administrative Law Judges, DCRA to stand as ordered.

The ANC 6C representative at the December 5, 2006, hearing on this matter will be Mark Dixon, Chairman of ANC 6C. Mr. Dixon serves at this hearing in the absence of the Single Member District commissioner, Mr. Lawrence Thomas, who has been ill for some time.
