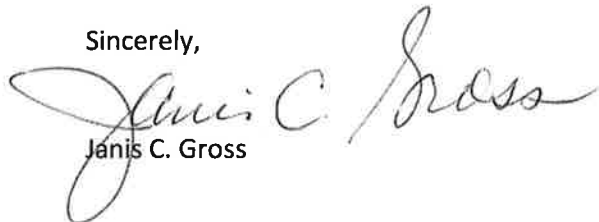
TO THE BOARD OF ZONING ADJUSTMENT MEMBERS:
