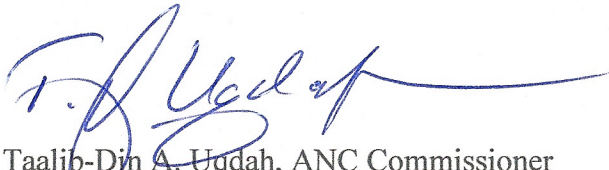
ANC/SMD 4C01 OPPOSITION
GOROVE/SLADE TRAFFIC STUDY REVIEW
(POST APRIL 26, 2016 PUBLIC HEARING)

Upon further review of Gorove/Slade's (G/S) Technical Memorandum dated May 05, 2016, I find Figure 4/Page 6, showing the 4300 block of Georgia Avenue, between Allison and Buchanan – marked unrestricted – does not take into account that the Westside of the block, (along miles of Georgia Avenue), has *Street Cleaning* restrictions, beginning Wednesday/10:00PM, to 5:00AM Thursday. On the Eastside, the restrictions begin at 10:00PM Thursday, until 5:00AM Friday, making G/S's Figure 5/Page 7, somewhat skewed.

Figure 5 shows 70% to over 90% occupancy on either side of Georgia Avenue, but that would have to change, as there is street cleaning starting Wednesday thru Friday, every week from March thru October.

Further, if you consider street cleaning on the Eastside of Georgia Avenue, Thursday night into Friday morning, Figure 6/Page 8 – conducted *Friday*, April 29th – doesn't make sense – 70% to 90% occupancy – that's restricted from 10:00PM Thursday to 5:00AM Friday.

Through no fault of their own – G/S was following DDOT's instructions – concluded their observations and assessments at 9:00PM, falling an hour short, as DPW starts its work at 10:00PM. One hour later, the parking patterns and occupancies would have looked considerably different, assuming residents were obeying the law's parking restrictions.



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
