Good Morning,

To Whom it may concern,

Woodbridge Daycare Center has been in operation since 1952. We currently have 3 facilities in operation. All centers must have an outdoor play space in close proximity to its location. In 2017 Bruce Monroe Community Park will be under construction, this playground serves as the site for our 2 centers located in the uptown region. This upcoming city project will directly influence our facilities, ultimately the children will not be able to have outdoor play on this site during this period. OSSE, as well as the Board of Zoning mandates that we must have an available outdoor space for children to play for at least 45 mins per day. In order to reconcile this issue Woodbridge is requesting a letter of permission/ permit from Parks and Recreation stating that our children have the authorization to occupy Raymond playground during this period where Bruce Monroe will be under construction. Each center has a vehicle that will transport the children to and from the Raymond playground. Woodbridge Daycare 3 is located at 424 Irving street NW, WDC 20010. The other site is Woodbridge 4 located at 629 Columbia Road Nw WDC 20001. Each facility has a max occupation of 27 children (8) Under 12 months, (8) Under 24 months (11) 24months – 48months. Each center has 9- 10 staff member employed. During transport there will be 4 staff member on each van to supervise and ensure the children's safety on the vehicle as well as the play site. The mandated time allotted for outdoor play is 10am -10:45am. All documents must be submitted to BZA on October 24th 2016. If possible, we respectfully request an approval for the permit prior to this date, to ensure we submit a completed application by the deadline given to us by BZA. Should any further questions or concerns arise please contact me directly on my cell phone @ 202-607-6645 or via E-mail. We have completed a permit application for both centers.
