Dear Mr. Hill,

I have been a resident of my house, which is within 200 feet of the proposed site, since 1988. For some reason, I was not listed in the list of individuals who live within 200 feet. I love this neighborhood and my neighbors, but life has not been easy for me since I lost my beloved husband Norman in 2008 and struggle with asthma every day.

I oppose the special exceptions to the zoning laws that the city is asking for. This crazy design is so large that even though I live several houses down the street, my house will still be in its shadow. I treasure my sunlight in the morning. Seventy feet is too tall and you should not allow the height exception. Dropping 200 people, with residents and staff, into the middle of our quiet little community of two story bungalows is unnecessarily disruptive. The city's claim that this is the last remaining parcel of land in Ward 5 where a shelter can be placed, which is the reason for all these crazy exceptions, is nonsense.

Please reject the city's request for all these special exceptions. I just want to live in peace and quiet.
