The CHRS Zoning Committee filed a letter of support in this case on April 17, 2018. The decision was predicated, in part, by letters of support from both adjacent neighbors and by the lack of any opposition to the project. On May 14, I received a telephone call from the neighbor immediately to the north of the subject, 123 Tennessee Avenue, advising me of her withdrawal of support. I subsequently became aware that the neighbor at 119 had also withdrawn his support and that the neighbor two doors to the north was also objecting. You have letters regarding the withdrawal and objections in your file.

This written information along with the shadow study was circulated to the Committee by email because our next meeting isn't until June 14.
