#### REFERRAL MEMORANDUM AND NOTICE OF PUBLIC HEARING

An individual, organization, or ANC is alleging an error in the determination or decision made by an administrative officer in the administration or enforcement of the Zoning Regulations of the District of Columbia (Regulations) regarding property within your ANC's boundaries. This appeal was filed on <u>August 20, 2018</u> through the Interactive Zoning Information System (IZIS).

**Appeal of Station Townhouses LLC,** pursuant to 11 DCMR Subtitle Y § 302, from the decision made on June 21, 2018 by the Zoning Administrator, Department of Consumer and Regulatory Affairs, to revoke Certificate of Occupancy CO1503518, permitting the property to operate as a mixed use retail/apartment building in the MU-4 and NC-10 Zones at premises 701 2nd Street N.E. (Square 752, Lot 49).
