**Application of Ekop I Graham,** pursuant to 11 DCMR Subtitle X, Chapter 10, for area variances from the lot dimension requirements of Subtitle D § 302.1 and the side yard requirements of Subtitle D § 306.3, to construct a new semi-detached building with two principal dwelling units in the R-2 Zone at premises 1138 51st Street N.E. (Square 5201, Lot 809).
