Dear Members of the Board,

On December 1, 2021, at a duly called and properly noticed public meeting with a quorum (at least five Commissioners) present and acting throughout, Advisory Neighborhood Commission 2F (ANC 2F) voted unanimously (seven in favor with no abstentions) to support the applicant's requests as enumerated:

- A special exception to the lot occupancy requirements of Subtitle G § 404.1 (pursuant to Subtitle G § 409.1 and Subtitle X § 901.2)
- A special exception to the rear yard requirements of Subtitle G § 405.2 (pursuant to Subtitle G § 1201 and Subtitle X § 901.2)
- A special exception to the minimum parking requirements of Subtitle C § 701.5 (pursuant to Subtitle C § 703.2 and Subtitle X § 901.2)

After consultation with members of the community, the ANC was satisfied that the proposed project would not negatively impact neighbors.

After careful scrutiny and consideration, the ANC urges the Board, pursuant to District of Columbia Code § 1-309.10, to accord great weight to its advice and approve the application.
