We find it one of the most special neighborhoods in D.C. – close to a metro, multiple robust commercial strips, multiple fantastic playgrounds, and backing up on rock creek park. It is a neighborhood we want to share with as many as we can. We were happy to learn that the house that recently sold across the street from us would be torn down to build two new houses as the only way we can share this neighborhood with more families is to have more housing. D.C. is not getting any bigger and we should not give up the greenspace that makes this city special. Therefore, the only way we can meet our collective goal of 36,000 new units is more density where it makes the most sense: near commercial areas and metro stations.

We write in strong support of the special exception for the Harrison's to subdivide their property to build two homes where there is currently only one. That subdivision many years ago certainly had a drastic change to the look and feel of the neighborhood.
