Re: Applicant's Opposition to Ms. Anderson's Second Status Request - BZA Case No. 21101

Dear Chairperson Hill and Members of the Board:

The Applicant in the above-referenced case is submitting this in opposition to the second party status request by Ms. Anderson. The party status requestee does not meet the criteria for approval and the request is not timely given that the original hearing was scheduled for July 24, 2024 and the upcoming hearing is October 2, 2024.

The complaints are related to general fire safety and therefore the requestor is not more significantly, distinctively, or uniquely affected in character or kind by the proposed zoning action than those of other persons in the general public. The Applicant would also like to correct the assertion that there is another Child Development Center within 600 feet. Based on a review, the next closest one is approximately 1,200 feet.

We do not believe the Board has opined on the first request, but for the reasons stated above, we continue to oppose any party status request.
