I live in Eckington and am writing in support of the zoning exception request for 2324 N. Capitol St NW. I am in support of this request for the following reasons:

- (1) The neighborhood does not have many restaurants, and families could use more places to eat out that are walkable and accessible.
- (2) Parking is rarely if ever difficult in the neighborhood, except for during street cleaning (which is unrelated to restaurant activity).
