Please accept this public **comment in support of the application for a variance / special exception for the Indigo 2 restaurant**, which was submitted by Dinesh Tandon and Nidhi Tandon for the property located at 2324 N Capitol St, NW (identified as Case 21151).

I am strongly supportive of granting the variance/exception and allowing this property to be used as a restaurant/bar with outdoor seating. I am a resident of the neighborhood - I live less than a mile from the proposed restaurant location, in ANC 1B01 in LeDroit Park. Our neighborhood would benefit significantly from more restaurants, which can benefit our local economy and provide a pleasant community gathering place.

Furthermore, I have been a patron of the original Indigo restaurant in DC for years, and it is fantastic - great food and drinks and friendly staff, at reasonable prices.
