Dear Ms. Roth,

The Office of Zoning has received your document today related to BZA Application No. 21157 of 3428 O Street, LLC. To help clarify the process, please review Subtitle Y §§ 602.6 and 602.7 regarding Requests to Reopen the Record. They state:

§ 602.6:

Any supplemental material received by the Board after the close of the record that bears upon the substance of the application or appeal shall be returned by the Director and not accepted into the files of the Board. However, if the materials are accompanied by a <u>separate</u> request to reopen the record, the request shall be accepted and presented to the Board for consideration. The request must demonstrate good cause and the lack of prejudice to any <u>party</u>. Such requests may be granted by the <u>presiding officer</u> and, if granted, the supplemental materials shall be entered into the record.

§ 602.7

The Director shall notify the parties by e-mail of the acceptance of supplemental material. Any response by a party to such supplemental material must be filed no later than seven (7) days after the date of the e-mail notice.

- 1) As you will see, the Regulations separate out the "Request to Reopen" from the "Supplemental Material".
- 2) If the document that you attached to your email is your <u>supplemental material</u>, we will hold that document out of the record until you submit your "Motion to Reopen the Record" on Form 150. (It would be a "Motion" instead of a "Request" for you because you are a Party.)
- 3) On Form 150, please address good cause and the lack of prejudice to any party.
- 4) The Chairman/Board will review the Motion and the Supplemental Material so he/they can make a decision on the Motion to Reopen the Record.
- 5) Then we will proceed based on that decision, as directed in §§ 602.6 and 602.7.
- 6) No responses from other Parties will be accepted unless the Motion is granted, and Parties are informed by staff.
