They bring culture and aesthetics along with a sense of calm which is so needed in our time. What they offer is unique.

As a tea lover myself, I know that pouring of tea and the sale of tea are integral to the authentic experience of drinking tea. I encourage the Board to allow Ching Ching Cha to continue serving tea and selling tea-related products. The Board would also be supporting a small, quiet, local business while contributing to cultural diversity in the neighborhood

On a personal note, I moved to Washington in 1978 - into the house immediately adjacent to this property on 21st Dt. I've known this street for all these years though I've moved a few blocks away. Ching Ching Cha is perfect on this block.

Furthermore, I believe that the granting of area variance relief from C-204.9(b) is warranted given the unique circumstances of the property. The mixed-use nature of the building, coupled with its commercial history dating back to at least 1972, presents practical difficulties in conforming strictly to zoning regulations. Denial of this relief would not only impose practical difficulties on the owner, as the pouring and sale of tea are integral to the existing art gallery use, but also risk the loss of a cherished community asset.

I urge the Board to approve the special exception and variance relief sought by Three Tables, The LLC.
