 - o Left turn across NY Avenue traffic impacts
 - o DOC pattern of insufficient parking
- Detainee Processing
 - o U.S Marshals will not transport until after "no-paper" determination detainees are out of custody at CCB
 - o No "no loitering law" in D.C. detainees/ family/ friends can remain in public space at will

III. Traffic

o DGS underestimates number of trips to and from site

IV. Windows

- Proposed film requires additional HPO review confirmed by HPO
- o At eye-level detainees can attempt communications with those outside

V. Noise

- o ANC 2G submitted multiple examples of protests & demonstrations at the current CCB
- o MPD will not intervene with megaphone or noise unless in violation of the Residential Tranquility Act only applies to residences
