My name is Michael Frankhuizen and since 2011, I reside at 437 New York Avenue, NW Number 502. I implore the Board of Zoning Adjustment to deny the special exception relief sought by the District of Columbia Department of General Services in their request to temporarily relocate Central Cell Block to 501 New York Avenue NW. Such a move, as I understand it, constitutes a clear violation of existing zoning ordinances and the current map.

If approved, the increased noise and traffic congestion from the substantial addition of cells and detainees as well supporting police and service provider operations will exacerbate an already near gridlock environment.
