- 2. ANC reports and any accompanying documents must be submitted to the record by using:

 - b. By email to zcsubmissions@dc.gov for the ZC or bzasubmissions@dc.gov for the BZA; or
 - c. In person or by U.S. mail addressed to 441 4th Street, NW, Suite 200-S, Washington, DC 20001.
- 3. Submission deadlines are as follows:
 - a. ANCs must file this form at least seven (7) calendar days in advance of the hearing, if they wish to participate in a public hearing under Subtitle Z § 406.3 and Subtitle Y § 406.3.
 - b. In all cases before the ZC or BZA, ANCs must file this form before the ZC or BZA makes a decision in order to receive great weight.

WHEREAS. on August 30, 2024, the applicant Stacy Roberts filed a request, docketed as BZA 21207 (15 Rhode Island Ave NW), to construct a one-story side

addition to an existing, semi-detached two-story with cellar principal dwelling unit, involving three items of relief: (1) variance from lot occupancy requirements, (2) special exception to rear yard requirements,

and (3) special exception to side yard requirements; and

WHEREAS. ANC 5F hears community input on zoning matters within its jurisdiction,

and while this project is located without ANC 5F the Office of Zoning has requested ANC 5F's consideration due to the project's proximity to ANC 5F (within one block), and the matter was discussed and public input requested at the ANC 5F Zoning & Development Committee meeting in November 2024 and the ANC 5F Commission regular meetings in October 2024 and November 2024, and ANC 5E has approved a resolution supporting the requested relief, and BZA will consider the

matter on December 18, 2024;

THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that ANC 5F supports the requested relief in BZA 21207 (15 Rhode Island Avenue NW), because it is compatible and appropriate, that there would be undue hardship on the owner if the requested relief were denied, and that there is community support for the proposed use; and requests that BZA give this determination great weight;

and

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the sponsor of this resolution is directed to transmit a copy of this resolution to appropriate recipients and is authorized to represent themself as speaking on behalf of the 5F Commission in advocating for the aforementioned.
