Written statements, in lieu of personal appearances or oral presentation, may be submitted for inclusion in the record, provided that **ALL WRITTEN COMMENTS AND/OR TESTIMONY MUST BE SUBMITTED TO THE RECORD AT LEAST 24 HOURS PRIOR TO THE START OF THE HEARING**. The public is encouraged to submit written testimony through IZIS at <https://app.dcoz.dc.gov/Login.aspx>; however, written statements may also be submitted by e-mail to bzasubmissions@dc.gov. Please include the case number on your submission. If you are unable to use either of these means of submission, please contact Robert Reid at (202) 727-5471 for further assistance.

Advisory Neighborhood Commission (“ANC”)

The property for which zoning relief is requested is within or adjacent to the boundaries of ANC 2B, which is therefore an “affected” ANC and automatically a party in this case. Please contact your ANC commissioner to learn how to participate in your ANC’s deliberation process and to find out if or when the Applicant is scheduled to appear before the ANC. The Board must give “great weight” to the “issues and concerns” raised in a written report of an “affected” ANC approved at a properly noticed meeting that was open to the public by the full ANC with a quorum present. The Board may give “great weight” to the oral testimony of the

“affected” ANC’s authorized representative if it complies with the requirements of Y §§ 406.3 & 406.4.
