WHEREAS, on January 28, 2025, the applicant (Network Building + Consulting, in association with Verizon Wireless) filed [BZA 21726](#) proposing to replace an existing light pole next to the football field on the campus of McKinley Tech High School with a telecommunications monopole, and said application requesting special exception relief pursuant from [DC Zoning Code Subtitle C Section 1302](#) (prohibiting antennas in residential zones) pursuant to [DC Zoning Code Subtitle C Section 1313](#) (providing procedure for approving monopoles in residential zones) and [DC Zoning Code Subtitle X Section 901.2](#) (authorizing Board of Zoning Adjustment to grant special exceptions); and

WHEREAS, on November 18, 2024, the applicant presented to ANC 5F, sharing [photo renderings of the project](#) and answering questions from commissioners and the public, and on December 23, 2024, [all property owners within 200 feet](#) were notified of the application and invited to submit feedback; and

WHEREAS, on December 23, 2024, the D.C. Department of General Services (DGS), on behalf of McKinley Tech High School, [stated its grant of permission](#) to the applicant for the construction of the monopole; and

WHEREAS, this project will help address inadequate cell phone reception on Quincy Lane NE and other areas of Eckington, and the applicant has endeavored to minimize any negative visual impacts of the proposed monopole;

THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that ANC 5F supports the granting of the relief requested in BZA 21276 (151 T Street NE); and

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the sponsor of this resolution is directed to transmit a copy of this resolution to appropriate recipients and is authorized to represent themselves as speaking on behalf of the 5F Commission in advocating for the aforementioned.

This resolution came before ANC 5F at a duly noticed public meeting on March 18, 2025.

ANC 5F is composed of 7 Commissioners, so that 4 Commissioners constitute a quorum.
