
Dear Chairman Hill and Members of the Board,

I am a parent of a student currently attending John Burroughs Elementary School (JBES) and a member of the School Improvement Team working with DGS and DCPS on the upcoming modernization project. I understand that the application is seeking variance relief under Subtitle C § 302.2 to allow multiple primary structures on a single record lot, in order to construct a temporary modular “swing space” at the Burroughs site, which is located in the R-1B zone. I am writing in support of the temporary zoning relief requested for the proposed modular swing campus at the Burroughs site.

I have reviewed the plans for the temporary campus and believe the requested relief is reasonable and necessary to allow another school to occupy the modular campus while maintaining the single record lot. It is my understanding that the requested relief will only apply to the modular campus and no other primary structures, and that the modular campus on the historic Burroughs field is temporary, and will be occupied by only one, or possibly two, additional schools after JBES, before being fully restored to open greenspace to be used by current and future JBES students and the public. The modular classrooms will provide a safe and well-designed temporary learning campus for DCPS students during construction of their school.
