**SUBJECT:** BZA Case No. 21327 – 4433 19th Place NE

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#### **APPLICATION**

Yeabsira Geda and Muluwork Kenea (the “Applicant”), pursuant to Title 11 of the *District of Columbia Municipal Regulations (DCMR)*, requests the Board of Zoning Adjustment (BZA) grant a Special Exception from the child development home standards of Subtitle U § 251.1(b)(3) to expand the capacity of an existing child development home from nine to 12 children. The site is in the R1-B Zone at 4433 19<sup>th</sup> Place NE (Square 4186, Lot 35) and is served by a 16-foot public alley.

#### **RECOMMENDATION**

The District Department of Transportation (DDOT) has reviewed the application materials and has determined that the proposed action may lead to a minor increase in vehicle, transit, pedestrian, and bicycle trips on the localized transportation network. In addition, the project may result in increased pick-up and drop-off activity and slightly reduced availability of on-street parking within the immediate area. Despite these minor impacts, DDOT has no objection to the approval of this application.

DDOT’s lack of objection to this application should not be viewed as an approval of the public realm. If any portion of this or future projects at the property propose elements within District-owned right-of-way or the building restriction area, the Applicant is required to pursue a public space construction permit. It is noted that the site has a 15-foot Building Restriction Line (BRL) along the 19<sup>th</sup> Place NE. The area between the property line and BRL is the building restriction area, which is regulated like DDOT public space and should remain “park-like” with landscaping.

DDOT expects the adjacent public realm to meet all District standards. The Applicant should refer to Titles 11, 12A, and 24 of the [DCMR](#), the most recent version of DDOT’s [Design and Engineering Manual](#),

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and the [Public Realm Design Manual](#) for public space regulations and design guidance. A permit application can be filed through the DDOT [Transportation Online Permitting System](#) (TOPS) website.
