As my property abuts the rear of your property and I cannot access that portion of my home from my side, I am requesting your cooperation to access the area temporarily and with care.

I also want to note that under the D.C. Property Maintenance Code (12-G DCMR § 104.4), the District encourages proper upkeep and supports reasonable access for property maintenance related to public health and safety. If I do not hear from you by May 9th, 2025, I may pursue support from the D.C. Department of Buildings or other appropriate channels.
