Hello Brian,

My name is Jackie Jacobson and I live at 1508 Swann St, NW in Washington DC. I have been referred to you by PD Klein at the Dupont Circle Conservancy. Also, Pablo Velasco Rodriguez, Constituent Services Coordinator for Council member Brooke Pinto, Ward 2 has been in contact with the DOB on my behalf regarding an issue with illegal construction by a neighbor at the rear of my property.

I'm a first time home owner and purchased my new home in February of 2022 after having rented in DC and the surrounding areas since graduating from college. I love my house, neighborhood and being part of the DC community.

In early July of this year, I observed my neighbor at 1818 15th St NW initiating a construction project that abuts to the rear wall of my house with little to no setback and at eye level with my living room. My neighbor texted me on July 8th and said that he was "only building a carport to cover his car" and to be "rest assured that we're not going to cover your window or obstruct your view or light in anyway". After subsequently having a brief discussion with him while walking in the neighborhood, I texted him on 7/15 and asked him about the permit that he had mentioned in our brief discussion that he said had gotten approved. I also asked him about zoning ordinances and let him know that I had not received any notice of the permit. He did not respond to this text.

After receiving no response to my text, I initiated an illegal construction notification process with the DOB, reference # 24ENF-IC-03011. The DOB sent out an inspector that issued a citation for illegal construction, i.e. constructing without a permit on 7/22/24. The Inspection Results from the DOB for 1818 15th St NW Issue Citation, being Owner had a rear deck installed without a Building (Deck) Permit, which he stated he thought his Architect obtained the permit, but no permit was listed in the DOB Accela System.

After the citation was issued, I observed my neighbor continuing and completing the construction of the illegally constructed elevated deck that abuts the rear wall of my house and is at eye level with my living room floor level. The most recent actions at the end of July were to add a trellis that blocked the view of the rear window in my living room, then in early August a black tarp that both blocked and darkened the view of the rear window in my living room and most recently in early September has added a flag to block the view from the other rear window in my living room.

At the suggestion of Pablo Velasco Rodriguez, Constituent Services Coordinator for Council Member Brooke Pinto, Ward 2, I have submitted a follow-up on the Illegal Construction Request and have asked for a stop work order to be issued.

The concerning impacts to me for this illegal construction that abuts the rear of my property with little to no setback and that is at eye level with my living room is 1) access to and functionality of piping for my home that runs up the rear facade 2) reduced safety and security-there is now easy access to my home from the elevated deck, 3) loss of privacy, 4) loss of natural light and view and lastly 5) potential reduction in the market value of my home.

I hope this email finds you well. DOB sincerely apologizes for the delay in responding to your earlier communication. I wanted to provide you with an update regarding illegal construction at 1818 15th St NW.

On October 11, 2024, a Stop Work Order was issued by DOB concerning the deck and garage, which were constructed without the required neighbor notification, permits, and final inspection. Additionally, a new fence was installed without obtaining the necessary permits.

Inspector McCottrey is scheduled to conduct an inspection today, January 13, 2025. This inspection will address the tarp currently covering the living room window and verify that zoning regulations are met.

At the request of management, DOB is also requiring an engineer's report on the structure that was built, as well as the blueprints for the construction.
