Re: ANC 2C Resolution in Support of BZA Case No. 21428 – The Daniel Alexander Payne Community Development Corporation – Residences at Metropolitan (“Applicant”)

Dear Chairperson Hill and Members of the Board:

At a regularly scheduled and properly noticed public meeting held on January 13, 2026, with a quorum of 4 of 4 commissioners being present, Advisory Neighborhood Commission (“ANC”) 2C voted to support approval of BZA Case No. 21428. The resolution was approved by a vote of 4-0-0.

ANC 2C supports the Applicant’s request for

- area variance relief from the minimum rear yard requirements (Subtitle I § 205.1); and
- special exception relief from the minimum penthouse setback requirements (Subtitle C §1506.1); and
- long-term bicycle parking requirements (Subtitle C § 807.2)

in order to construct new apartment units to serve homeless veterans (the “Project”). Accordingly, ANC 2C strongly recommends that the BZA approve the application.
