Your Home Occupation Application HO1600168 filed to use the subject premises as an Expanded Child Development Home for (10) to twelve (12) individuals is placed on hold due to the need for Board of Zoning Adjustment approval.

You will be required to obtain a Special Exception pursuant to the 2016 Zoning Regulations, Subtitle U, Home Occupation Uses, Section 251.6 to allow for an Expanded Child Development Home for 12 Children (Ages 6 weeks to 12 Years of age) and Four staff.

The Board of Zoning Adjustment has authority to grant a special exception under The 2016 Zoning Regulations, Subtitle X, Section 901.2.

This letter must be presented to the Office of the Board of Zoning Adjustment, Room 210, 441 4<sup>th</sup> Street, N.W., when filing for the hearing. If your request is granted, documentation is required to be provided to this office for completion of the zoning review and approval of your application.

Note: All applicants must provide the Office of the Zoning Administrator with submission verification, in the form of a formal receipt from the BZA, within 30 days of the date of this memo.
