Highlight location of change with cloud or similar method. 1. [DCMR 12A 108.3] Upload the estimated cost of construction in supporting document folder signed by owner and contractor. Construction cost includes labor and material including for demolition. 2. [DCMR 12A 106.2] Description of work on application (accela) and on coversheet of the drawing does not match. Accela says two walls of 43.9" height at 8' apart, Coversheet says two walls of 3.5' and 6' at 28' apart. Retaining wall more that 48" in height needs engineering design to ensure stability against overturning, excessive foundation pressure and water uplift. Retaining walls shall be designed for a safety factor of 1.5 against lateral sliding and overturning. [R404.4] Provide signed and sealed design calculation form registered design professional licensed to work in DC or upload manufacturer's specification showing allowable design height of retaining wall in supporting document folder. Uploaded specification sheet does not show information on height limitation. 3. [R312.1.1] Provide guardrail on the top of middle retaining wall (3.5' high?) as it is taller than 30" form lower ground level. Sheet Typical Detail 3.5' wall, Civil-2 4. [DCMR 12A 106.2; R312.1.1] Provide construction detail for new staircase form alley. Show handrail and guardrail. Sheet Civil-2 Further comments may follow after re-submission.
