Telecommunications Monopole at 3401 4th Street SE Washington D.C.

Overview: The new 120' telecommunications monopole tower located 3401 4th Street SE Washington D.C. is designed to accommodate multiple Federal, District, and private radio and cellular users. The tower facility is unmanned and hard wired directly to municipal electric and telephone service. All equipment will be enclosed by fencing to prevent easy access to the tower and limit exposure to the drip line (or ice) from the antennas/tower.

- 1.** A DGS representative will access the facility once per quarter to assess the proper functioning of the facility. Grounds maintenance will also be performed on a quarterly basis to remove any accumulated trash or debris and to control any weed growth.
- 2.** The tower tenants are responsible for the maintenance of their own equipment installed on and underneath the tower.
- 3.** DGS will post all required FCC notices on the exterior of the site with identification information and a toll free 800 number for the public to report any issues or concerns regarding the site.
