

STATEMENT OF PUBLIC OUTREACH

I, Jim Schulman, AIA, am the Architectural Representative for Athos Pashiardis, owner of 122 V St. NW, with respect to his application to the BZA for special exception relief. I have communicated by email, phone, and text message with Athos' Advisory Neighborhood Commissioner, Robert Vinson Brannum, Commissioner of ANC 5E08, requesting to have our project be included on the agenda for their upcoming monthly meeting on the evening of May 21st. The meeting is scheduled to take place at 7pm at the Friendship-Armstrong Public Charter School Cafeteria, at 1400 1st St., NW. We have been warned that because the ANC has a very full schedule, it is likely that the ANC 5E Chairperson, Bradley Ashton Thomas, may move our presentation to the third Tuesday in June.

Commissioner Brannum also recommended that we present, if possible, on May 20th at the monthly meeting of the Bloomingdale Civic Association. I have emailed the Civic Association, and reached out to Ms. Teri Janine Quinn, their President, via LinkedIn. Having not received a response, we will attempt to be given a chance to speak at their monthly meeting at 7pm at the St. George's Episcopal Church at 160 U St., NW. If we are unsuccessful, we intend to approach the historic association that last year succeeded in obtaining historic district status for the Bloomingdale neighborhood.
