

## **Statement of Public Outreach**

In accordance with the requirements of Subtitle Y-300.8 (1), we have conducted the following outreach activities to our local neighborhood and ANC 3F06.

1. Personal conversations with the property owners at 3617 and 3621 Everett Street NW were held several times; first in August and September of 2025 when the design of the porch was finalized, and again in late March, prior to filing. Both neighbors voiced their full support for the application and the architectural design of the porch. In late March. Their email responses are attached.
2. A copy of the submission was emailed in August of 2025 to a neighborhood Listserv which contains the majority of the houses on both Everett and Fessenden Streets, and the portion of Nebraska Avenue which abuts the two blocks. We received several comments in return, which were all in support of the application and the architectural design of the porch;
3. A copy of the application was emailed to Courtney Carlson, the Commissioner of ANC 3F06 on March 25, 2026. We will respond to any further requests from the ANC.
