Dear Chairwoman Mitten:


I have been a resident of Chevy Chase Heights in Washington, D.C. since 1978. I have watched Wisconsin and Western grow from sleepy mom-and-pop townhouses to what is now a high-density mixed-use urban area. No additional traffic capacity has been added in all of this time.

Yesterday I drove from my home on Jenifer Street to River Road. It took twenty minutes. I had to cut through side streets and drive a gauntlet of traffic blockages. This was at 7:00 p.m., supposedly after rush hour. The worst area was the intersection of Western, Military, and Wisconsin.
