
At a duly noticed public meeting on November 14, 2005 ANC 6D voted unanimously to support the application of Florida Rock Properties, Inc. for a second stage PUD for the property at 100 Potomac Avenue SE.

The ANC is enthusiastic about the changes that the Applicant has made in its proposal since its initial proposal of several years ago. The Commissioners are particularly pleased with the inclusion of, as well as offices, residential, hotel and retail space in the project, and its sensitivity to both environmental and community concerns. The inclusion of such amenities as green spaces, a waterfront promenade, bicycle path and access from public thoroughfares through the project to the water are particularly welcome to the Southwest/Near Southeast community.

In addition, the use of environmentally sensitive materials and systems (such as a bio-filtration system for storm run-off and green roofs) are to be applauded.
