At a regularly scheduled and properly noticed public meeting on February 18, 2025, with a quorum being present, a quorum being three commissioners, Advisory Neighborhood Commission (ANC) 6/8F voted 5-0-0 for the resolution in support of the applicant's requested modification of significance as described in ZC Case No. 04-14H.

The applicant presented at our ANC's administrative meeting on February 5, 2025, and again at its public meeting on February 18, 2025. Our ANC supports the project, namely the change in use from office/hotel to residential, which increases housing opportunities – including affordable housing – in our community. Our ANC also supports the provision of expansive green spaces in the site plan, particularly the dog park which will almost certainly become a heavily-used neighborhood amenity.

The temporary dog park located on the project site today is already a valuable resource for the greater community, and our ANC supports the inclusion of a permanent dog park in the project that will remain open to the public. Finally, our ANC also supports the open spaces that allow for pedestrian circulation along the Anacostia River and facilitates enjoyment of the river and surrounding areas.
