This letter is to advise the district of Columbia Zoning Commission that I fully support the DC Primary Care Association's (DCPCA) PUD Application to the DC Zoning Commission for the following:

Final approval of a Planned Unit Development and Zoning Map Amendment (Zoning Case No. 05-28B)

Corresponding Modification to an Approved First Stage Planned Unit Development (Zoning case No. 05-28E)

As a resident of Ward 7, I understand the importance of providing quality health care in my neighborhood, an area that the federal government has designated as a Health Professional Shortage Area. As reports have revealed, the health indicators for Ward 7 and 8 had generally higher rates of chronic disease, poor health status, and premature mortality than in other areas DCPCA has an extraordinary track record of developing health centers in other wards. To date, they have completed 8 renovations and expansions across the city, and have another one in construction in Ward 8. As a resident of the community, I ask that the Zoning Commission approve this application so that Ward 7 can have its own new, state-of-the-art primary health care facility.
