This letter is to advise the District of Columbia Zoning Commission that the Lotus Square Tenants Association supports the development project at Parkside. CityInterests presented to the Lotus Square Tenants Association on November 30, 2010 about the development. Lotus Square is located adjacent to the Parkside development on its northeast side and is one of the communities represented in the Parkside Civic Association.

Bringing the flagship campus of the Community College of DC to Parkside will benefit the community as a whole. CCDC will provide educational opportunities for the neighborhood's Cesar Chavez Public Charter School graduates, as well as for adults in the neighborhood seeking a post-secondary degree. Residents in the Parkside/Kenilworth community have identified a need for access to better education, and the introduction of CCDC will complete the "educational conveyor belt" from early childhood through adult education that residents' desire. By providing a curriculum tailored to the workforce needs of the DC job market, CCDC will help prepare Parkside's children and families for the jobs of the future.

Furthermore, residents of both Parkside and the Seventh Ward as a whole are in desperate need of higher quality, more accessible health care. We believe that the proposed health care clinic at Parkside will be a great improvement over the services offered at the existing Hunt Street clinic, and we hope to see this project through to fruition. Overall, Lotus Square-Kenilworth Ave Apartments residents will benefit from the increased vitality of the neighborhood, the jobs, retail, and educational opportunities that will be available to them with this development, and the increased safety that comes from more daytime and evening use of these facilities.
