Dear Commissioner Mitten and Members of the Zoning Commission:

Citizens Aware (CA) hereby presents this testimony in opposition of the West Group development proposal with a recent police report attached (Attachment #1). We have previously submitted two letters voicing our opposition to the proposed West Group (WG) project located at 6000 New Hampshire Ave. NE. Upon reviewing the Office of Planning hearing transcript, we wrote to the Office of Planning with copies going to pertinent entities on February 9, 2006 (Attachment #2). We also wrote a letter in June 2005 (Attachment #3), both letters we would like to present as part of the testimony of Citizens Aware and both are heretofore attached. We have also submitted 272 signed petitions (Attachment #4) signed by the community which were solicited by two of our members, Dr. O Martin and Dr. A Kelly.

On May 11, 2005 CA held a meeting and agreed to allow a 4B08 mini single Member District meeting, requested by ANC Commissioner Cherita Whiting, to take place simultaneously with our meeting. At that meeting CA and 4B08 took a majority vote on the WG property to determine if the majority members were in favor of a zoning change or not. The result was to keep the current zoning "as is" for the entire property (and therefore <u>not</u> support the current WG proposal as it requires a zoning change.)

Listed below is our rationale for voting against a zoning change and thereby voting against the project.

- A zoning variance would drastically increase the community population. According to WG, 80 single family homes (SFHs) could be built on the property leaving the existing buildings in keeping with existing D.C. law, and 100 SFHs could be built on the property if the existing buildings were torn down. Yet, under the PUD, the developer is asking for a total number of homes almost double the capability under the current zoning. So hypothetically, if only one person lived in the homes, under the current zoning there would be 100 more people added to the community. But under the PUD, seeking almost double the number of homes, 200 more people would be added to the community. We think a zoning change that

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would minimally double the number of housing units on that parcel of land is above and beyond the vision, culture and historical use of this community. The zoning for this property in the current Comprehensive Plan is R-1-B.

Too few SFHs and increased condos and townhouses would change the identity of the property as one that is no longer a SFH property. Although Georgia Avenue and New Hampshire are markedly different in appearance, they have both been identified as "Gateways" to the city. As such, the City has recognized the value of these neighborhoods and has promised special fix-ups to these portals into the city. The difference in the two avenues is that Georgia Avenue has historically been a commercial corridor and the City celebrates that tradition with Georgia Avenue Day. When you enter the city via New Hampshire Avenue you are impressed that this is a community where families and elderly could comfortably live and navigate. The citizens of the New Hampshire Avenue/Lamond Riggs community think that this is worth celebrating, maintaining and fighting to keep.

It has been in numerous newspapers lately how the City has adopted a pro business strategy. The evidence is all around us in the form of new commercial and real estate development. In light of the business community's renewed interest, Ward 4 has been targeted for mixed use development at an alarming pace. There are at least six mixed-use housing developments with condos and townhouses either under construction or identified for construction within 4-6 blocks of the proposed WG property, including both sides of South Dakota and Riggs Rd NE, and the Ft. Totten Metro area. Accordingly, we are concerned about increased density in the short and long-term.

And while we applaud the new business and how it has made the city better, let us not forget the die-hard, long-term taxpayers who have always recognized the city's beauty, have worked hard to keep their property pristine and at the same time supported the city financially with their hard earned tax dollars for many years when the business community was not interested.

Major traffic arteries are jammed currently, especially during rush hours. A large population increase due to the high ratio of townhouses and condos to SFHs would cause more traffic to flow to the major arteries and overflow into side streets. Said problem has not been satisfactorily addressed. New Hampshire Ave. comes to a dead end at North Capitol Street (NC) and a traveler going south into downtown D.C. must go either right or left. (A house on NC Street creates a dead end at North Capital and New Hampshire Avenues.) There is a traffic light there because traffic on NC is already bumper to bumper. However, that traffic light serves to back up traffic on New Hampshire Ave. across the line into Maryland because travelers going south into D.C. must stop for the traffic light at the dead end on North Capitol Street. Where will these moving cars flow? Kansas Avenue, which flows traffic south to downtown also, is already backed up going south into the City; it is mostly one lane and it backs up at the light at North Capitol Street (yes, the same North Capitol St. mentioned above). Peabody St. NE is a side street off of New

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Hampshire and many Maryland and DC residents use this 2-block street as a short cut to go from New Hampshire to Eastern Ave. At Eastern Ave. a right turn gives easy access to Riggs Rd. where traffic can turn right into DC or left into Maryland. During rush hour this residential shortcut is highly traveled and at high rates of speed. So much so that CA requested a speed bump on Peabody St. which has not stopped the high rates of speed.

In addition, traffic jams are accentuated during any construction, i.e., two major construction projects have occurred on New Hampshire Avenue in the past two years. One is complete and one is currently on-going on the small bridge between Oneida Streets and First Street. This construction is only in the first phase and it has cut down on the number of lanes on NH and is contributing to traffic backups. This project will go on for another 2-3 years. Other proposed construction projects will add to traffic congestion.

WG boasts of having parking for every housing unit and having even more parking spaces above that for guests. This may well serve as an incentive for homeowners to have more than one car. Some will already have more than one car. We know additional parking is already needed when residents have guests or parties. Many current residents have upwards of 3-4 cars per household as children still live at home with parents and create extended household living situations. We are concerned that in light of these realities, not enough parking will exist in the WG property to prevent those future residents and their guest from searching for parking in the existing, surrounding streets where parking is already limited.

- Townhouse/condo dwellings are more likely to be resold/rented at a quicker or higher rate than SFHs. This could result in constant turnover in the development which could affect the upkeep and value of properties in the community as a whole. Newspapers have already reported how many investors buy condos for rental purposes. We have already stated the pride and the desire we have to keep New Hampshire Avenue as a Residential Gateway to the City. We must add that we are ready to continue the hard work it takes to keep this community well groomed and green. Ours is a community of mature residents where many have lived here for 50 years. The homeowners have pride, confidence, feel safe and know their neighbors and neighborhood. The culture of this neighborhood could easily be compromised by a mixed unit development and the number of people that would populate that corner of land.
- The developer is not offering real solutions to some problems that the community knows will become issues later on. WG has stated that the fact that properties on the proposed development cannot be bought for resale and cannot be rented out once purchased and this could only be changed by going before the zoning or some other city commission will become apart of the condo documents.. WG probably can make this arrangement now, but when the homeowners who will be paying \$300,000-\$600,000 for these homes decide this provision in the condo documents does not work for them, then WG will have left the community and the

newcomers as well as those living in the community now will not have access to WG to help resolve issues. Other issues that WG would solve with the condo documents or the condo association are:

- The proposed private streets would have to be maintained by the condo association including snow removal, maintenance and repair.
- Senior building activities and funding of those activities would have to be handled by the condo association.
- Upkeep for park areas
- Likelihood that resident condo fees will continue to pay for park upkeep yet parks are available to entire community

We would like to know that real solutions for these problems and any others proposed to be in the condo documents are negotiated to now as we cannot rely on regulations in condo documents that have not been produced.

- Community services, i.e., ambulance, police, schools and other services burdened by the sudden population increase in the area. Local officials have already casually stated in meetings that they did not see a problem with same. In addition, as of July 7, 2006, the community has not seen written reports on these issues. Other issues, major and subtle, but not exhaustive, to be considered for a development of this kind that also need answers include:
 - o increased electric customers
 - o how many more gallons of water usage per day
 - o incidences of graffiti in the neighborhood
 - increased pet population, general animal control, and pet feces proper and improper disposal
 - o the need for school building availability, closings, openings and renovations
 - o telephones, telephone wire and wireless remote access
 - o the need for public parks, play spaces and recreation area
 - o increased fire department houses and firemen
 - o increased police protection
 - o incidences of road maintenance
 - o trash collection plan
 - o addition, maintenance and repair of sewers, sewer mains and new lines
 - o historical drainage and wetness problems on the property
 - o mail delivery and collection
 - o addition of street lights
 - o air quality with increased cars/exhaust with driveway parking

One of the larger supermarkets in our community, Tiger Market, which is the closest one to our community and the WG project in Washington, DC on Rigss Rd., is slated for closing to make way for new mixed housing in the next two years. The next closest supermarket is Safeway at Georgia Ave and Piney Branch Road, 20-25 minute driving distance from our community and the WG project. Right now and continuing, our major grocery shopping needs and the tax dollars that go along with that are going to Maryland stores as we are obligated to go to Maryland to do our

grocery shopping. We would like to see the City look more comprehensively at providing a supermarket in the area to accommodate the planned influx of new residents and new housing developments. With the increased population density that the WG project and other upcoming projects will bring, we are concerned that our access to retail services will become even more challenging, and lead the community to do more shopping in Maryland.

The WG project does not fit within our community. It serves to undermine the hard work DC residents have invested their lives in to preserve and maintain this community. Native Washingtonians will tell you that unlike New York City or even Baltimore, Md, this city has a reputation for being a big "small town" because it has a long tradition of single family neighborhoods. We maintain that what has established this city, its family neighborhoods, is still valuable and the city is big enough to have commercial areas elsewhere and yet maintain the historic novelty of having single family neighborhoods that nurture children, provide an outlet for families and afford the elderly and all the community a walking neighborhood to each others' homes to visit or to go to the post office, etc. without congestion, traffic or fear of witnessing or becoming a crime statistic. On many occasion the Police Dept. has come into our community meetings to corroborate that crime is a greater problem in the Georgia Avenue corridor than in the New Hampshire Ave. corridor and that police are pulled from our area to service Georgia Avenue when there is need. A recent crime report for PSA 402, population statistics (Attachment #1) and conversations with the Metropolitan Police Department resoundingly confirm that crimes are committed at a higher rate in areas where higher populations reside.

We propose that we are willing to work with West Group to exercise its option to use "matter of right" and develop all single family homes on the site in accordance with the current zoning laws. All single family homes would give an economic boost to the community, enhance the New Hampshire Avenue Gateway and be in compliance with the current Comprehensive Plan.

- No WG proposal has been presented to our satisfaction that addresses our preference for more SFHs. WG has stated that the rationale for having SFHs in the front of the property on NH Avenue is to keep the neighborhood looking as much like the other homes in the neighborhood as possible. If that is the case, we would think that the first place WG would start would be to develop the property as SFHs to comply with the current zoning, the Comprehensive Plan for the area and the desire of the community.

We do thank WG for their efforts in presenting this project to the community. However, whether intentional or unintentional, we feel that at times WG did not give all the detailed facts in an intelligent and a more easily understood manner that we needed to make an informed decision. The project was complicated and its essentials changed on numerous occasions. Some meetings WG started off with an 8 X 11 piece of paper with colors and geometric shapes on it and described it as the project, rather than initially provide us with a written plan that also discussed the governmental/zoning issues. They graduated to an 11 X 14 piece of paper. We kept waiting for the 3-D model, they finally promised one but we have yet to see it. We met with WG at various meetings for about 1 ½ years before their lawyers sent official correspondence in August 2005 notifying neighbors for the first time that the property required a zoning change. We recently heard that WG is changing the proposal AGAIN, which brings up old fears of not having enough information in enough time to intelligently prepare or make rebuttals to changes.

Furthermore, WG stated they came up with a list of community benefits they thought we needed, without real input *from* the community. We have not begun to negotiate benefits with WG because there is not much WG can offer us to get us to change the character and culture of our community. It has worked for us as a SFH community. With the City treasury in the black from so much real estate tax revenue, we are willing and know how to work within the system to get help for our libraries, schools, etc. that need financial help; therefore, WG's offer is no real benefit to us.

To the Zoning Commission, thank you for hearing the community on this issue and for letting us be apart of the process. Entertaining WG and the many presentations and changes they have made to this project, as we look back, the one thing we all admit that we have come away from this whole experience with is that where you live, and the character of that community, is important. It provides comfort and familiarity. The residents of this community realize we may pay higher taxes opting for a SFH development, yet we are willing to pay the price for an old friend that we know and love, our neighborhood, our community with an R-1-B zone.

We, the members of the Citizens Aware Block Organization, petition the Zoning Commission to vote to maintain the exiting zoning (R-1B) in the case of 05-30. Thank you.

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

Dear Chairperson Mitten:

I am writing in my capacity as president of the Citizens Aware Block Organization regarding the on-line transcript from your Nov. 14, 2005, public meeting on the West Group PUD application (Case No. 05-30). Citizens Aware represents residents who would be directly affected by the West Group plan. We have held several meetings about this project, and have met with West Group representatives on several occasions and frankly this project is so complex that we, as residents, are still trying to understand all of the technical jargon to make intelligent decisions on what is best for our community. The Office of Planning gave an initial assessment of the application to the Zoning Commission that exposed an unbiased professional point of view which was very enlightening in deciphering the developer's past presentations. As a result, below are keys points that we strongly feel must be brought to your attention from the community's perspective.

Page 52: "... property is four houses ...with 10,000 square feet." (Observation: These numbers not correct. There would be more than four homes, less than 10,000 sq. ft each.)

Page 52: "The proposed map amendment would rezone the site from R-1-B to R-5-A which allows Land Use Map which recommends the subject site for low density residential." (**Observation:** What is being proposed in this traditionally low residential area is high density, not low density.)

Page 53: "Amenities provided by this project will be an attractive and functional residential community that promotes homeownership with a variety of housing types to encourage long-term residency and increase neighborhood stability." (**Observation:** This is more the definition of what the developer's mission is rather than a community amenity. The community *already* has mostly long-term, and stable, residents.)

Page 53: "Flexibility would be required from several provisions of the Zoning Regulations, including the lot occupancy, side yard requirements for townhomes and single-family residences, FAR requirements for the proposed townhomes and relief from sections 410 and 2516 of the Zoning Regulations for the townhomes to be considered as groups of single buildings."

(Observation: It is one thing to be flexible, but why must established rules be bent so far back and be bent on so many counts to accommodate this project, especially considering the quote below?)

Page 54: "We believe that the applicant is getting twice the number of residences that would be allowed under R-1-B Zone, which is approximately 360,000 square feet and then with 257,000 square feet of density. (**Observation:** One of the *chief* complaints and concerns of the community is increased density. We don't want two times as many homes crowded onto this plot of land.)

Page 54: "We have asked the applicant to submit additional info prior to the Public hearing for further review, including highlighting all the units that do not meet the yard and other requirements..."

(**Observation:** Once again, concessions are given to the developer beyond the standard requirements. Please make sure this is addressed at the public hearing by the developer.)

Page 55-56: "At the top I see a few sites where there's going to be a proposed storm drain, proposed storm drainage, but my concern is the New Hampshire Avenue side and those families who will be having those basements. I'm not sure how the water is going to run off and that's my concern..."

(**Observation:** The transcript mentions a 45-degree slope in reference to this statement. As a resident in the area, anyone can tell you that this hilly property *always* has had water and drainage problems. Proper and sufficient drainage of the property is a must for homes, basements, street run-off, drainage, ice and pedestrian safety.)

Page 56-57: "We understand that the density is increased, but we did agree that the applicant's statement when it was broken down into number of units per acre for the site, it fell right between the R-2 and the R-3 density of 17 units per acre where the R-2 is about 14 units per acre and the R-3 is 22

units per acre. So in that respect, we believe that we can support it as being within the limits of that range of a single-family zone district."

(Observation: No. R-2 is 14 units and R-3 is 22 units, it sounds like by current law, 17 units does not fit into either zone requirements and gives the developer too much slack for both varying from R-2 and R-3 zone standards.)

Page 57: "And it also seems that when you were looking at their lot occupancy calculations that they were including the roadways and alleyway system as part of their lots. Is that correct or is that why their lot coverage is so low, because otherwise it seems like what would typically be a saleable lot is significantly smaller than what would customarily be allowed."

(Observation: If the City would approve zone changes or lot size changes to accommodate a citizen buying part of the roadway and alleyway as part of a home that would be unforgivable. Then, it is all the more important that no variation from zone standards be granted.)

Page 58: "My first concern is that it just seems to be too dense particularly compared to a surrounding neighborhood." (Observation: Yes, many in the community feel this way. Why should this community have to change the whole cultural face and standard of living it has become accustomed to?)

Page 65: "Well, overall, the community and the ANC supported the project."

(Observation: This is incorrect. The ANC has not taken a formal vote on this matter as of this writing. Therefore, it certainly *cannot be said* that they are in favor. In fact the ANC in whose Single Member District the property sits on has made it known that she opposes the development, and we understand she has recently written to you of that fact. Others are still formulating a decision.

Page 71: "...there is a zoning lot that is Lot E that is off of Peabody Street, N. E., and this is something that I have been dealing with the Board of Zoning Adjustment some, as well, but the concept that a trellis can be used to join two standalone buildings and, thus, create a single building for zoning purposes, I do not find anything in the Zoning Regs to support that and I would like to get that addressed by the applicant if this moves forward." (Observation: If no such animal exists under Zoning Regs, don't start the experimentation with us. Besides, it sounds like a bad idea. If the trellis blows down then will you have structural damage?)

Page 72: "One other thing is is there a problem with the proximity of Rittenhouse place with the intersection of Rittenhouse and New Hampshire Avenue? I'm not sure what the planned use level is of that road, but it seems to be one of the major streets through the development and it's a very short distance away from a fairly major intersection." (Observation: Yes, this is another serious community concern. Traffic is great concern with this project. New Hampshire is a major thoroughfare and a gateway to the city, and currently inadequately handles traffic from D.C and Maryland. These streets were designed at least 60 years ago for a residential community with few to no cars. Needless to say, the road does NOT currently handle the traffic sufficiently and the way traffic lights are set up out of necessity further impedes traffic. Furthermore, mass transportation on New Hampshire is not meeting current needs. Add to that 200 new households, 400-1200 new people in that development and pets — and don't let any other major occurrence be necessary like the current construction of a nearby bridge — and the result is chaos.)

Most key, at least two zoning commissioners expressed surprise that the community "approved" such a project, and one called us a "unique" neighborhood based upon experience with other neighborhoods. We cannot emphasize strongly enough that we ARE NOT unique regarding density concerns — neither *the community as a whole nor the ANC* has formally "approved" this project in a structured way.

Position on MedStar Property Redevelopment: No Zoning Change

June 2005

Dear Neighbors, Community Leaders, Government Officials and All Who May Be Affected by MedStar Property Redevelopment:

As many may know, MedStar Manor is in the final stages of selling its property at 6000 New Hampshire Avenue, N.E. As it stands now, the successful bidder is the West Group. Upon property ownership, West Group will first seek a change in zoning variance to begin construction on the largest new residential development project in our area. The planned zoning change is from the current R-1B designation (all single family homes (SFHs)) to a Planned Unit Development (PUD) (a mixed use of condos, townhouses and SFHs).

Citizens Aware, as one of the communities adjoining the said property <u>does not</u> support the West Group's current proposal. Our formal position is to keep the zoning, as is, for the entire site. We have a vested interest in what happens to this property as our organization's boundaries include: (1) the 6000-6100 blocks of New Hampshire Ave. NE (southside of Peabody St. NE to the southside of Rittenhouse St. NE); (2) the 6000-6100 blocks of 3rd St. NE (east and west sides of street); (3) the 200-300 blocks of Quackenbos St. NE; and (4) the 200-300 blocks of Peabody St. NE.

Background

Generally, as we understand it, there are two options for developing the MedStar property:

(a) Maintain the existing zoning for a maximum of 80 SFHs on a minimum 5,000 sq. ft. lot. per SFH Under this scenario, a developer can build homes without community input.

(b) Seek a zoning variance for other residential configurations under a PUD." According to the D.C. Office of Planning, a PUD "permits a developer to exceed the existing zoning density limitations and provides greater flexibility in planning and design. In exchange, the developer typically agrees to provide "certain" community amenities. Using this option, by D.C. law the developer and community work together towards a mutually agreeable development proposal.

The current West Group proposal on the table seeks a zoning variance under a PUD to: (1) renovate the existing buildings into 40-50 one and two-bedroom condos selling for \$250,000+; (2) build 129 townhomes with either underground parking or driveways for \$300,000 to \$350,000+; (3) build 17 detached SFHs along the perimeter of New Hampshire and Rittenhouse starting at \$400,000; (4) extend roadways like Quackenbos and other streets leading into the property, provide visitor parking and build a community center; and (5) set aside at least 10 units of "affordable housing" for a citizenry lottery. Including zoning and construction, this process will take 18 months to two years, and will include environmental, traffic and other studies.

The West Group has presented, after seeking community feedback, several revised proposals since the summer of 2004. Imminently, further changes are to come as the Group goes through its 12-18 month review by the D. C. Zoning Board.

April 25, 2005, Community Meeting

On April 25, 2005, a community meeting was jointly sponsored by Councilmember Adrian Fenty, ANC Commissioners Judy Jones and Cherita Whiting and Citizens Aware. The meeting's purpose was to gather community leaders, area community groups, Neighborhood Advisory Commissions (ANCs), government officials and the West Group in one place to formulate one, unified community position on the project, considering important issues such as aesthetics, density, traffic, property taxes and socio-economic factors. After much discussion on these issues, a consensus vote was sought. By a slim majority, the current West Group proposal received the most votes. However, this vote proved problematic for many citizens. Citizens Aware members and other community group members voiced that they did not have proper notification that the meeting's purpose was to make a community consensus vote/decision at that meeting and consequently many were not prepared to do so.

Citizens Aware Votes on Formal Position

After further considering the events and consequences of the April 25th meeting, a subsequent May 11, 2005 meeting was held. Citizens Aware, along with a 4B08 mini-Single-District Meeting presided over by ANC Commissioner Cherita Whiting, took a majority vote. The result was to keep the current zoning "as is" for the entire property (and therefore <u>not</u> support the current West Group proposal). The discussion leading up to the vote cited many factors for the position taken, including, but not limited to:

- A zoning variance would drastically increase the community population.
- Too few SFHs and increased condos and townhouses would change the identity of the property as a SFH property.
- West Group has not adequately addressed exactly how the new zoning of the proposed property would affect property taxes and resale values of homes in the entire community.
- Major traffic arteries are jammed currently, especially during rush hours. A large population increase due to the high ratio of townhouses and condos to SFHs would cause more traffic overflow into side streets. Said problem has not been satisfactorily addressed.
- Townhouse/condo dwellings are more likely to be resold/rented at a quicker or higher rate than SFHs. This could result in constant turnover in the development, which could affect the upkeep and value of properties in the community as a whole.
- Community services, i.e., ambulance, police, schools and other services could be overburdened by the sudden population increase in the area. Local officials have already casually stated in meetings that they did not see a problem with same.
- Earlier West Group proposals had more SFHs surrounding the perimeter than the current proposal. No proposal has been presented to our satisfaction that addresses our preference for more SFHs.

Feel free to share our position of "No Zoning Change" to all stakeholders in this matter, and at whatever forums and media outlets are appropriate.


Citizens Aware and the 4B08 Community will continue to follow, and be an active participant in, the progress of the proposed property development.


