The matter came before this ANC on April 9, 2007, after we heard from a member of the Stanton Park Neighborhood Association that the case would come before the Zoning Commission on April 19 ANC 6C's Zoning, Planning and Environment Committee voted unanimously 8.0 as follows

We oppose the text amendment as currently written

We need time to study the document

Because ANC 6C was not adequately and timely notified, we were unable to fit this item into the full-Commission April 11 agenda, which was already overcrowded. The matter of fast-food certification is so important that it will impact our community for years to come, and requires study and community input. Thus we respectfully ask for a postponement of the hearing to give us adequate time to study the matter in relation to our community. If this delay is not possible, we request that the record be kept open for 30 days beyond the hearing.
