Advisory Neighborhood Commission 8E supports the application by the District Housing Authority and CEMI-NMI Highlands LLC, a joint venture between Crawford Edgewood Managers, Inc. and New Market Investors LLC, for approval of a new residential community on a vacant portion of the site of the Highland addition public housing complex. This site is bounded generally by Condon Terrace on the south, 8th Street on the west. Valley Avenue on the north and 9th Street on the east, all S.E., in the Washington Highlands neighborhood,

The proposal is to construct 142 housing unit of various types, including row dwellings, detached semi-detached dwellings, and three unit buildings. New street system and public alleys are a part of the plan. ANC BE has supported this project from its Inception, and we continue to support it. This housing development is a welcomed replacement for the vacant lot that is currently there. We look forward to the ground breaking for this project.
