PROPOSED AMENDMENTS TO ZONING MAP

Southeast Federal Center

The Zoning Map of the District of Columbia, as incorporated by reference in 11 DCMR § 106, is amended as follows:

1. The boundary lines of the SEFC/C-R District that is located immediately west of the Navy Yard and bordered on the north by M Street, S.E., on the west by 3rd Street, S.E. (closed), on the south by Tingey Street, S.E. and on the east by Isaac Hull Avenue, S.E. are revised as described in the metes and bounds description attached hereto as Exhibit "A-1" and as depicted on the plan attached hereto as Exhibit "A-2".
2. The boundary lines of the SEFC/R-5-E District are revised as described in the metes and bounds description attached hereto as Exhibit "B-1" and as depicted on the plan attached hereto as Exhibit "B-2".
3. The boundary lines of the SEFC/R-5-D District are revised as described in the metes and bounds description attached hereto as Exhibit "C-1" and as depicted on the plan attached hereto as Exhibit "C-2".
4. The boundary lines of the SEFC/W-0 District and of the Development Area are revised as described in the metes and bounds description attached hereto as Exhibit "D-1" and as depicted on the plan attached hereto as Exhibit "D-2".

E. as shown among said Records; said parcel of land proposed to be Zoned "C-R" and being more particularly described as a single, consolidation perimeter outline in the WMATA Meridian as shown on a boundary survey prepared by A. Morton Thomas and Associates dated August 18, 2005.

BEGINNING at a point on the centerline of M Street, S.E. (90 feet wide), said point lying a bearing and distance of Due North, 45.00 feet from the northwest corner of the original Square 826 (now part of Southeast Federal Center), both as shown among the Records of the Office of the Surveyor, D.C.; thence running with the centerline of M Street, S.E.

1. South $89^{\circ} 57' 31''$ East, 694.27 feet; thence departing said centerline of M Street, S.E. and running as to cross a portion of M Street, S.E.
2. South $00^{\circ} 02' 29''$ East, 45.00 feet to a point in Isaac Hull Avenue, S.E. (width varies); thence running within said Isaac Hull Avenue, S.E. the following three (3) courses and distances
3. South $00^{\circ} 36' 06''$ East, 51.72 feet to a point, thence
4. Due North $89^{\circ} 21' 18''$ East, 20.21 feet to the centerline of said Isaac Hull Avenue, S.E.; thence running with said centerline of Isaac Hull Avenue, S.E.
5. South $01^{\circ} 30' 23''$ East, 88.21 feet to a point; thence departing said centerline of Isaac Hull Avenue, S.E.
6. South $88^{\circ} 29' 37''$ West, 11.43 feet to a point; thence
7. South $01^{\circ} 30' 23''$ East, 16.41 feet to a point; thence

8. South 89° 04' 49" West, 17.29 feet to point; thence
9. South 00° 31' 00" East, 31.33 feet a point; thence

14. North 89° 57' 31" West, 701.70 feet to a point intersecting and running with the common dividing line between future U.S. Department of Transportation, Lot 802 Square 770, and Southeast Federal Center
15. North 00° 02' 29" East, 176.97 feet to a point; thence
16. South 89° 57' 31" East, 414.74 feet to the southeast corner of 4th Street, S.E. intended to be dedicated and presently known for purposes of assessment and taxation as Lot 804 in Square 770; and thence running with the east line of said 4th street, S.E. (Lot 804), being the west line of original Square 826
17. North 00° 02' 29" East, 407.96 feet to the point of beginning, containing 496,207 square feet or 11.39135 acres of land









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

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
SKETCH SHOWING
