The Office of Zoning has received and reviewed the request for the application cited above, which requests:

Review and approval of a modification of significance to a previously approved PUD for property located in the southwest quadrant of the District at 65 I Street, S.W. (the former Randall School), and also known as Square 643-S, Lot 801.

The Office of Zoning has determined that your application is complete, that it meets the basic filing requirements, and that the appropriate filing fee has been paid. This application has therefore been accepted for processing.

The Office of Planning (OP) will further process this application prior to it being presented to the Zoning Commission. The initial consideration given to the application concerns whether the Commission should set the case down for a public hearing. OP will make a recommendation on that issue to the Zoning Commission at one of its monthly meetings.
