**Kalorama Citizens Association Resolution Concerning DC Zoning Commission Case No. 07-33: Reed-Cooke Overlay: Off-premises alcoholic beverage sales as a permitted accessory use.**


The Executive Committee of the Kalorama Citizens Association, representing the civic group directly neighboring the Reed-Cooke Neighborhood Association's (RCNA) boundaries in Adams Morgan, and a group whose members will also be affected by the proposed change to Title 11 (DCMR), Chapter 14, Reed Cooke Overlay District, Section 1401.1 (b) to be amended as follows (proposed new text in **bold and underline**):

**(b) Off-premises alcoholic beverage sales as a principal use; except that off-premises alcohol sales shall be permitted as an accessory use to a grocery store or other similar permitted use;**

do hereby support RCNA's vigorous request that the Zoning Commission deny this change to the Reed Cooke Overlay and to instruct Harris Tceter to apply to the Board of Zoning Adjustment (BZA) for a "Special Exception" as required by Section 1403 of the Reed Cooke Overlay.
