Dear Chairman Hood and Members of the Commission:

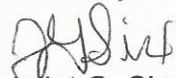
As you consider publishing the Zoning Regulations Revision for public comment, we respectfully request that the comment period be extended from the proposed 60 days to 120 days instead.

The revisions are very broad reaching, a dramatic re-organization of the code and there have been ongoing changes in the document that consists of over 900 pages. No comparative red-line version has been made available so searching the details in and of itself is very time consuming.

If DC land use is to be governed by these new rules, allowing adequate time to comment is imperative. We may be living under the new regulations for many years.
