I support language access here in DC and so should the Zoning Commission at your meeting on September 21, 2015.

Since the ZRR is a fundamental planning document for the District, central in guiding how the entire City develops for the next 100 years or more, this document ought to be available for all residents to review and provide comment on.

I want to see the ZRR documents be translated in to Spanish, Amrahic, and Chinese. And I want to see that more time -- four to six months -- is given to comment on the ZRR for ALL District residents.

I ask that you please uphold this request in the pursuit of justice and language access here in DC.
