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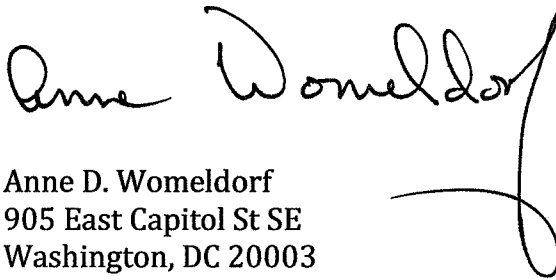

I have lived at 905 East Capitol St SE for more than twenty-five years and as a long time tax-paying citizen, I want to protest the proposed zoning changes related to parking.

Parking on our street has become increasingly difficult in my area. Many of the older houses do not have off street parking—there are no alleys in my block of East Capitol—so we are dependent on street parking; Driving around many blocks looking for parking late at night is not just inconvenient; it is not safe.

The proposed changes seem to have no advantages, except to big donor developers and disadvantages, even hardships, to residents. I, therefore, propose that the Commission retain existing minimum parking for new development and institutions, remove proposed penalties for providing necessary parking supply and ensure public process in response to any requests to reduce parking requirements.
