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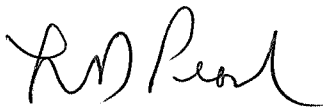

I have lived on Capitol Hill for more than forty years. In the last several years parking has become an increasing problem in my neighborhood. I have seen the proposed changes in zoning regulations relating to parking and I am adamantly against them.

I propose, instead, that the Commission retain existing minimum parking for new developments and institutions, remove proposed penalties for providing necessary parking supply and ensure public process in response to any requests to reduce parking requirements.

The Commission should also take steps to facilitate car sharing as a means of reducing the overall demand for on-street parking.



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
