

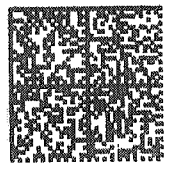

Re: Zoning Regulations Review (ZRR) Community-Based Public Hearings Scheduled for
February 8 -13

On January 30, 2014, the Zoning Commission (ZC) voted to allow ANCs and SMDs to testify again at the February ZRR community-based hearings regardless if they have testified before. The ZC stated that it was important to allow the additional testimony since ANCs and SMDs represent many District residents. Further, the Commission requested that should an ANC or SMD decide to testify again, that they confine their comments to new subject matter that they have not yet presented.
