CHURCHES SERVING AS NEIGHBORHOOD ANCHORS IN AREA PROPOSED FOR 16TH STREET HEIGHTS OVERLAY EXPANSION

Land Use Policy 2.3.6 of the Comprehensive Plan recognizes that churches and other religious institutions are "an important part of the fabric of the city's neighborhoods" and need to be" sustained as neighborhood anchors and a source of spiritual guidance for District residents." The following churches were established approximately the same time as the surrounding neighborhood and are an integral part of its character-defining features.
