Summary of the Testimony of Kwasi Holman

I am Kwasi Holman, Junior Warden at St. Augustine's Episcopal Church located at 600 M St SW, and I am pleased to appear in support of the application. As a southwest resident since 1963, and a member of the Church since its inception, I am excited about the potential this PUD offers to continue the presence of the Church for many years to come.
