These generally involve extensive engagement with community and civic groups as well as local government. He has served for four years on the Arlington County Public Art Commission.

In addition, Mr. Fitch has been active in design education. He currently teaches at the Washington-Alexandria Architecture Consortium, has taught in Harvard University's Graduate School of Design for three years and served on the faculty of the School of Architecture at Howard University for five years. He has also taught at the Rhode Island School of Design, the University of California at Los Angeles, the Catholic University of America and the University of Maryland.
